

St. Gerard Code of Conduct Procedures

Athletic Director or functioning leader will initiate the process by providing the materials for the athletic activity at the coach's meeting.

A.) Coaches Code of Conduct will be discussed with the coaches and signature obtained

B.) Parents Code of Conduct will be provided to the coaches to discuss with parents at a meeting and to distribute.

C.) Student Code of Conduct will be provided to the coaches to discuss with parents and students at the first meeting and distribute to all student-athletes.

Coach meeting is required for all coaches at the beginning of the activity season.

A.) Coaches including assistant coaches shall be required to attend a meeting regarding rules including the discussion of the Coaches Code of Conduct. Signature shall be obtained from all coaches on the Coaches' Code of Conduct.

B.) Athletic Director or functioning leader shall confirm that all coaches have signed the Coaches' Code of Conduct and have returned the form.

C.) Athletic Director or functioning leader shall confirm coaches have received the required Virtus Training.

Parent and Student-Athlete meeting held by the coaches will discuss the Code of Conduct rules for both the parents and the Code of Conduct rules for the students.

A.) Coaches will distribute the Parent's Code of Conduct to all parents.

B.) Coaches will distribute the Student Code of Conduct to all student-athletes.

C.) Student Code of Conduct should be discussed with all student-athletes regardless of grade in an age appropriate manner, but should be distributed for 3rd grade and higher.

A signed copy should be obtained for each activity that the Coach volunteers in, and parents and students should receive the forms in the meetings for each activity participating.

For example, if a coach leads a basketball team and then later also leads a volleyball team, the coach would be required to sign a Code of Conduct for each activity.

Code of Conduct policy will be in effect for all student-athlete activities.
