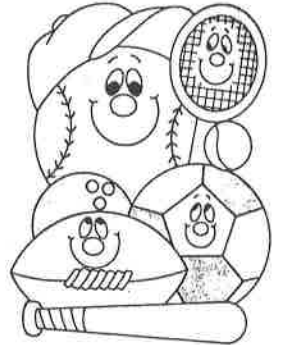
## JEANS DAY

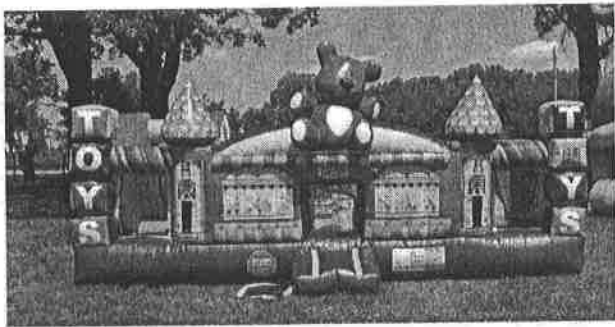

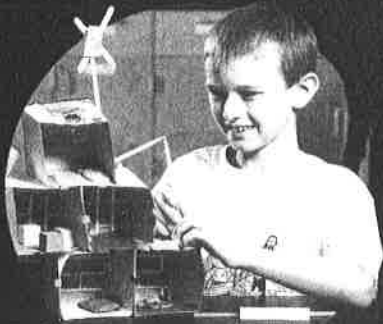
