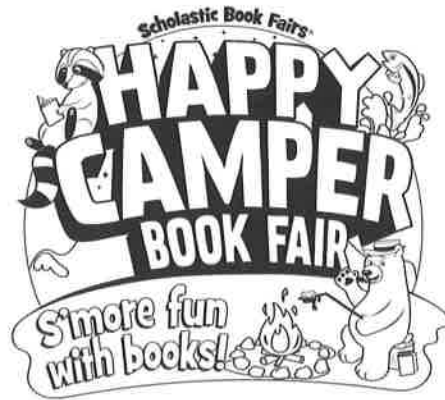
The book fair will be held in the Adult Ed Rooms of the school. These rooms are in the school's lower level, adjacent to Father Weber Hall.

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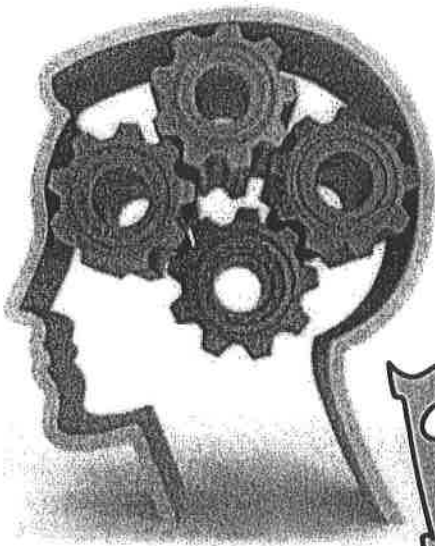

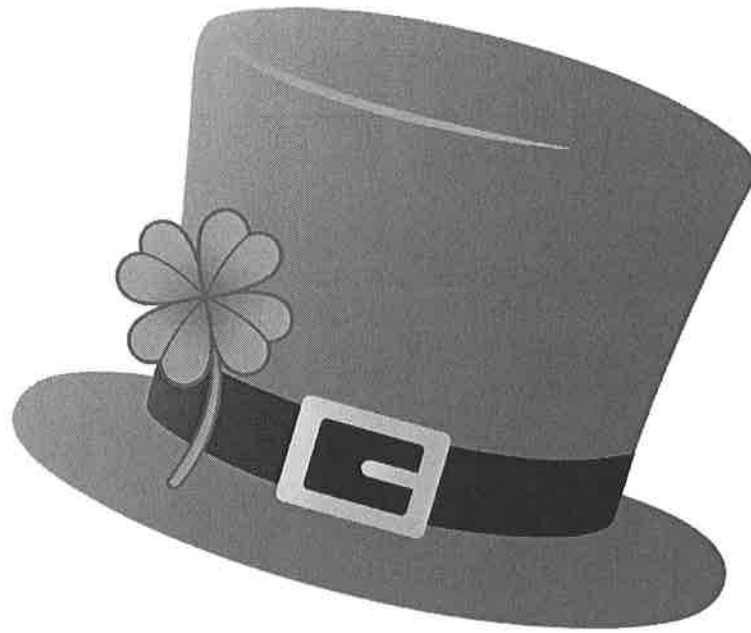

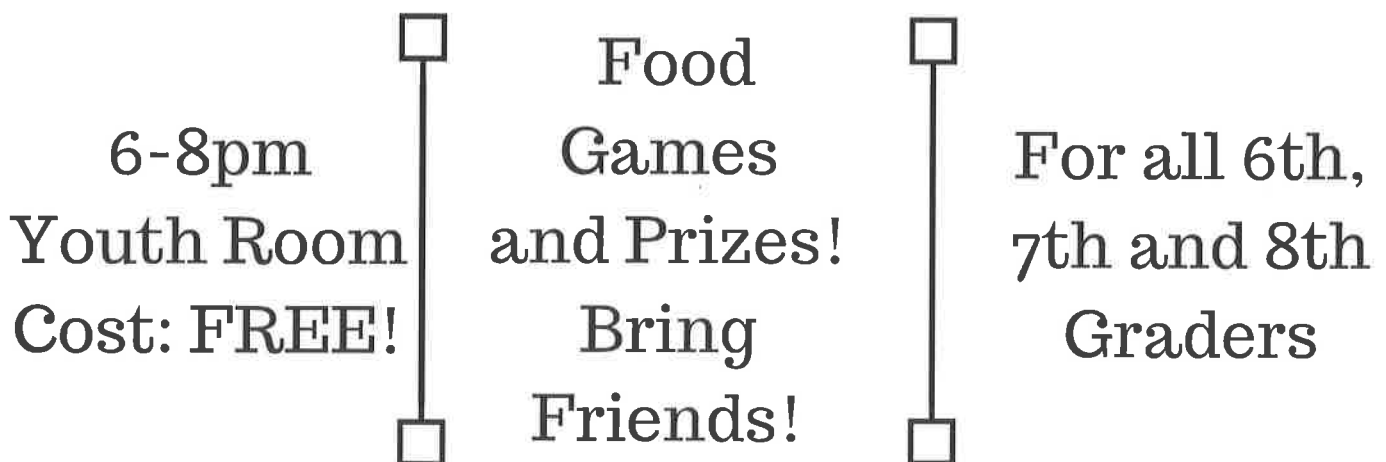
