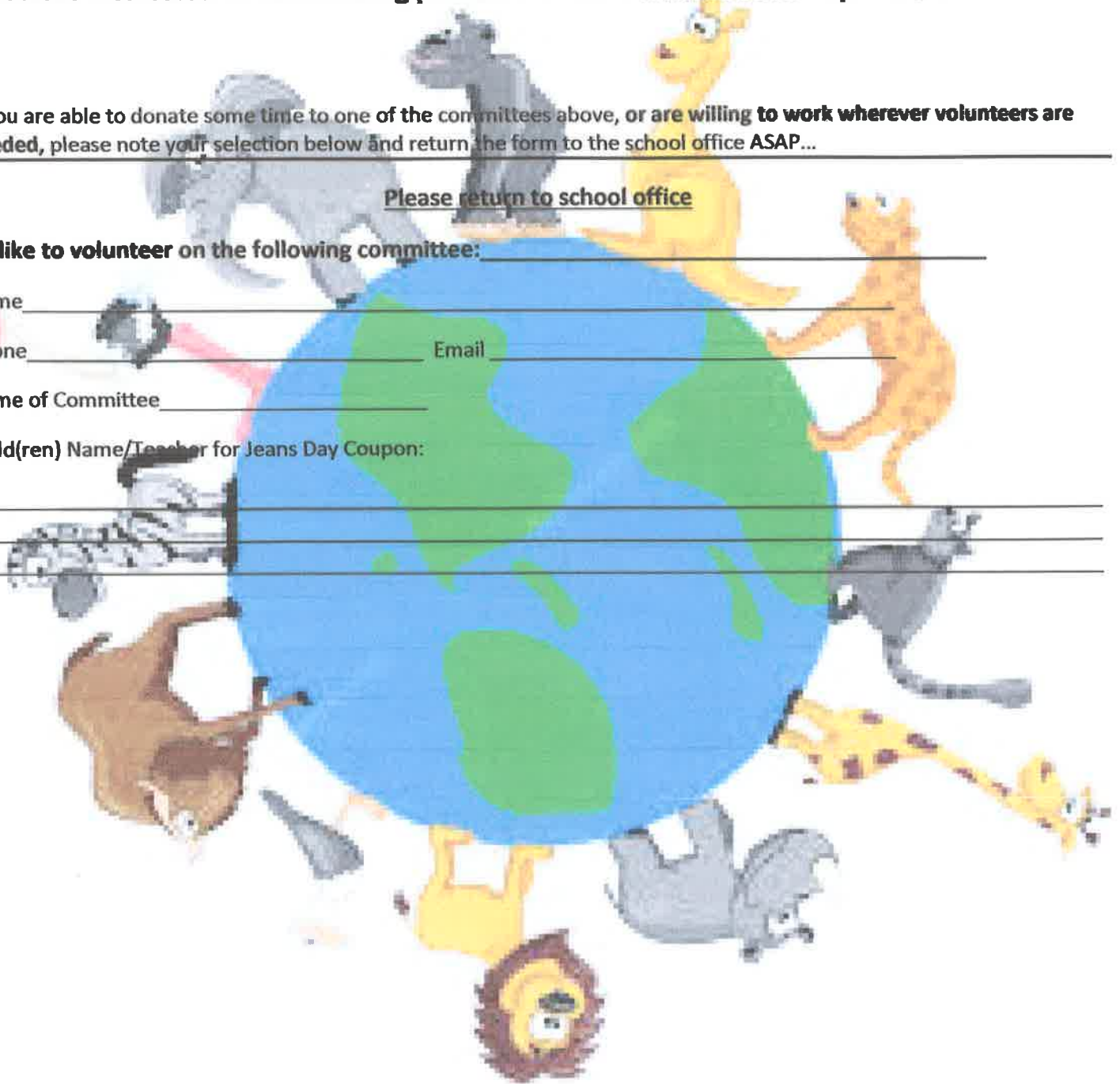

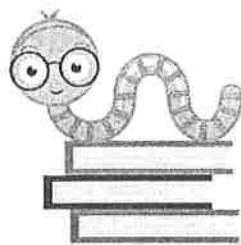

7th grade boys' registration and skills testing 7:00 pm on October 24, 2017

8th grade boys' registration and skills testing 8:00 pm on October 24, 2017

Skills testing for each grade level will take approximately 1 hour.

Please remember to bring to registration a **completed basketball registration form, a copy of a current physical form dated after April 15, 2017, and 2 checks: One for \$45 each to cover registration, and one for \$100.00 to cover concessions/Admissions shifts (check will be returned to you after you work the required 2 shifts)** made out to St Gerard Athletics. There is a mandatory \$10 late fee for all registrations received after October 24th. If you have any questions, please contact the St Gerard Athletic Director, Pat Malacina, at 230-7380. Boys will not be permitted to practice until all required documents and payments are received.

Note: Please do not bring the original copy of the physical. A copy will do.

There will be grade specific parent meetings during skills testing. You are highly encouraged to attend.

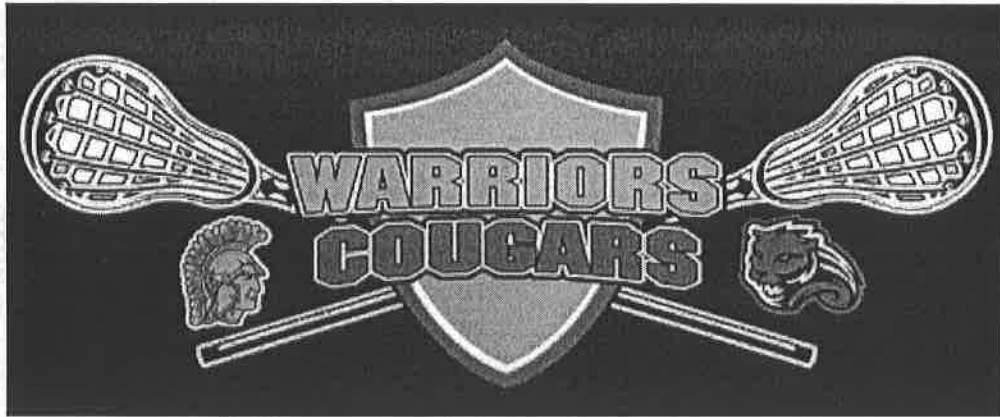

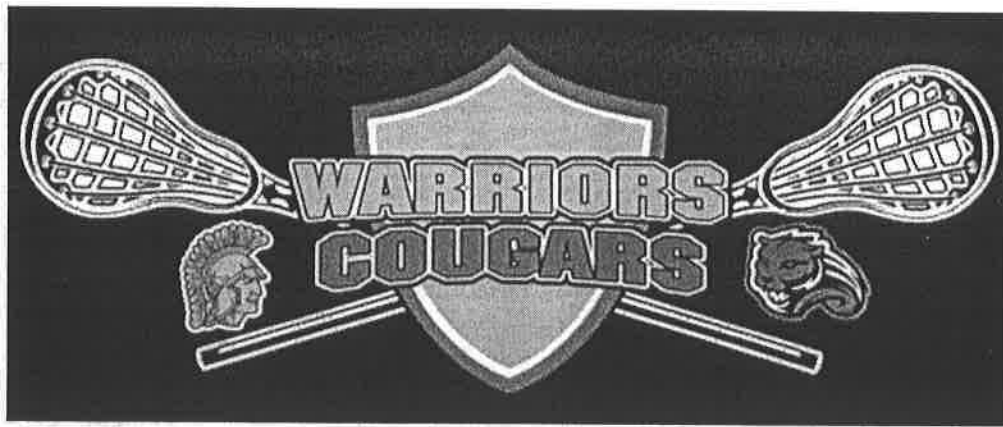
