St. Gerard Boys Basketball Registration for 2016 - 2017 - Mark the Date!

Basketball registration and skills testing for boys in grades 5th through 8th who attend St. Gerard School or regularly attend St. Gerard Religious Education will be held as follows:

5 th grade boys' registration and skills testing	8:00 am on Saturday, October 22 nd
6 th grade boys' registration and skills testing	8:30 am on Saturday, October 22 nd
7 th grade boys' registration and skills testing	9:30 am on Saturday, October 22 nd
8 th grade boys' registration and skills testing	10:45 am on Saturday, October 22 nd

Skills testing for each grade level will take approximately 1 hour with the exception of 5th grade, which will only have one team.

Please remember to bring to registration a **completed basketball registration form, a copy of a current physical form dated after April 15, 2016 and 2 checks: One for \$45 each to cover registration, and one for \$100.00 to cover concessions/admissions shifts (check will be returned to you after you work the required 2 shifts)** made out to St. Gerard Athletics. There is a mandatory \$10 late fee for all registrations received after October 22nd. If you have any questions, please contact the St. Gerard Athletic Director, Pat Malacina, at 230-7380. Boys will not be permitted to practice until all required documents and payments are received.

There will be grade specific parent meetings during skills testing. It is **MANDATORY** that a parent attends.

Season starts October 24th with games starting the week of November 7th.

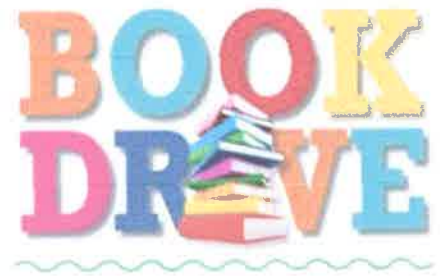

WASHINGTON DC FUNDRAISER!!

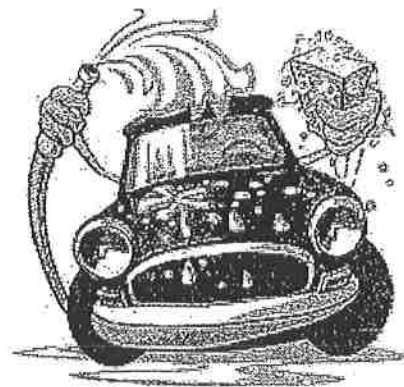

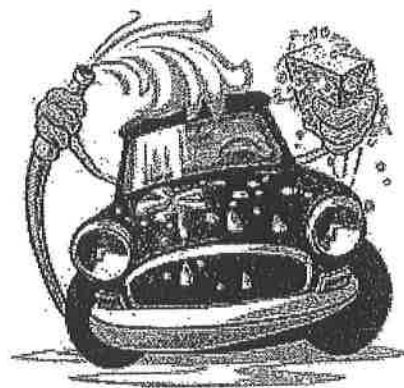

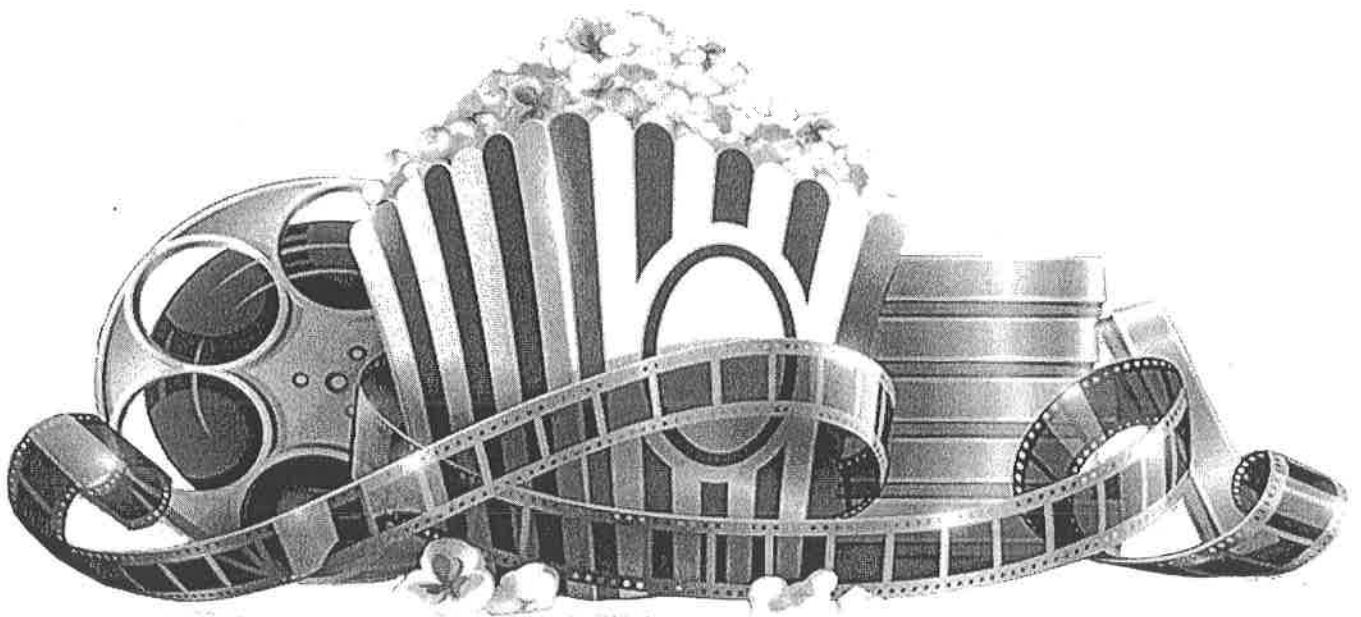
