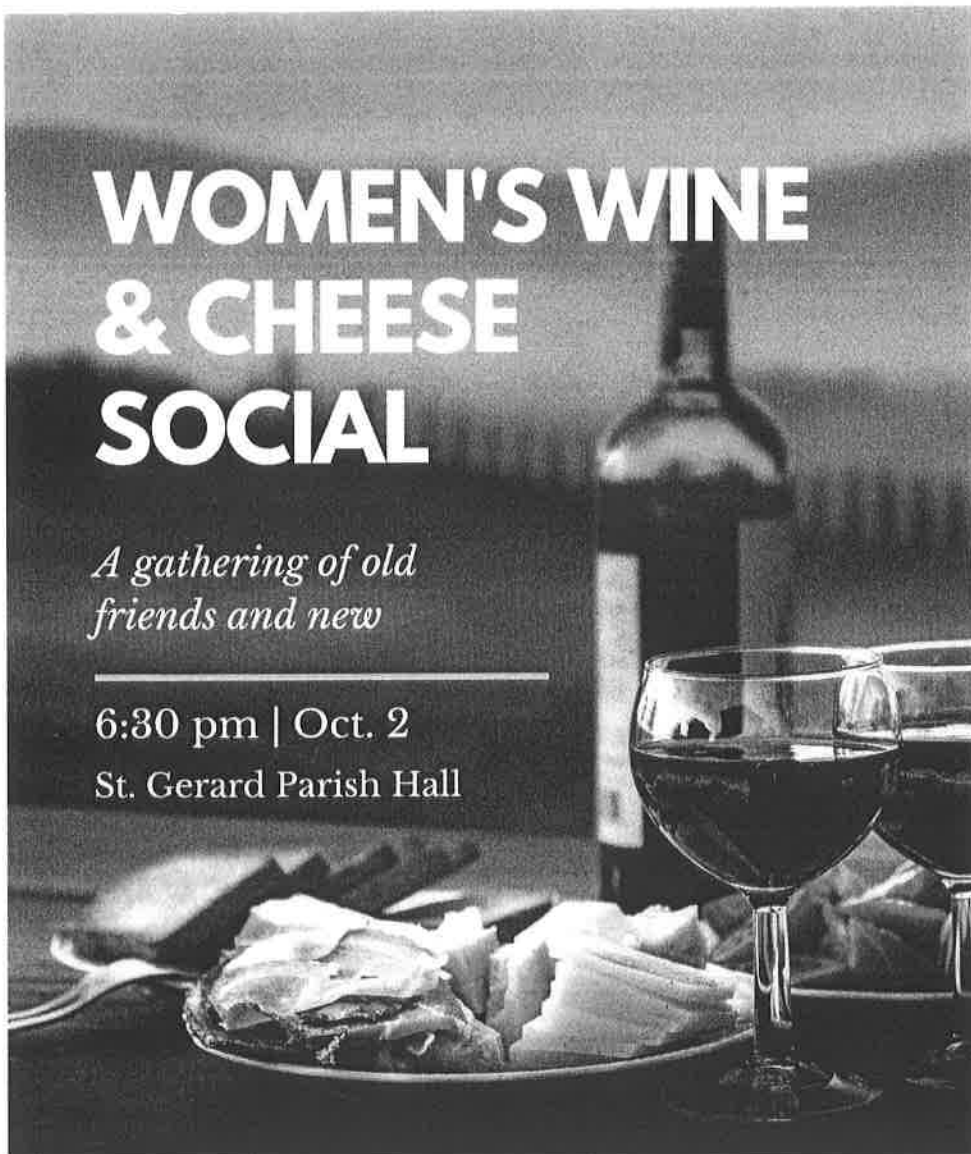

- You will see bottles being collected for several weeks after masses or you can place them in the collection baskets at church as well.

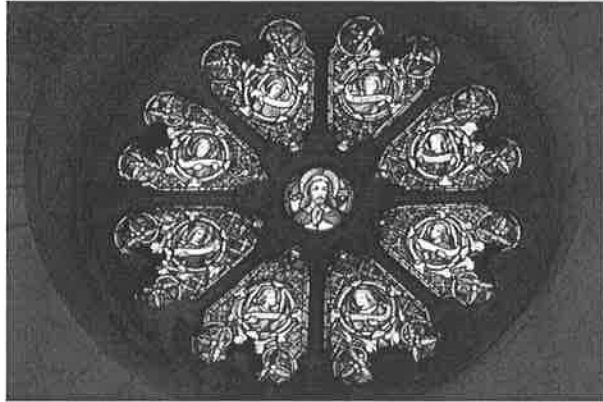
