Dear Parents,

My name is Rich Kimball and I retired from my job as Athletic Director at Lansing Catholic in 2016. Since that time I have been the boys varsity lacrosse coach in the Lansing Catholic, Waverly and Lansing Christian lacrosse program. This co-op has student athletes from all three schools playing lacrosse in grades 3-12, in the spring.

The past two weeks I have taken on a new role as a guest physical education teacher in all of the grade 3 through 8 PE classes at St. Gerard. Your children have brought great energy and enthusiasm to class every day while learning to play the sport of lacrosse! They have also worked very hard to learn how to play a game that most of them have never before encountered. I hope they have come home and talked about this "new" sport!

I started playing lacrosse when I was in ninth grade (which was a long time ago)! I was able to play and be a starter for four years in high school and college. I have started two high school programs from scratch when I was a high school history teacher. I was able to move up the coaching ranks when I became the Varsity Lacrosse Coach at Michigan State from 1981 to 1997 (the program was dropped when Michigan State came into compliance with Title IX.) In those 17 seasons, myself and my assistant coaches were able to build a Top 20 team and earn our way into three NCAA Division I tournament berths.

Now, my long term goal is to build the Lansing Catholic boys and girls programs into two of the better programs in Michigan. In order to get better, we need to have more young and excited players in our program! My short term goal this fall and early winter is to expose the sport of Lacrosse to as many of our catholic school children as possible with the end result of creating a new generation of lacrosse players!

Many of the students in the classes I have taught have expressed an interest in playing more lacrosse this spring. Our program is always looking to get more boys and girls playing this awesome sport! If you want to learn more about lacrosse, I will be holding a parent meeting on **Tuesday, Nov. 6 at 6:30 pm at St. Gerard School** in Father Webber Hall. We sponsor teams for boys in 3/4th grade, boys and girls in 5/6th grade, boys and girls in 7/8th grade and high school. We are always looking to get more kids involved.

If your child is interested in continuing to learn and play lacrosse, please attend our meeting on **Nov. 6th**. We will have sticks and equipment on display and lots of information about our program to give to you!
