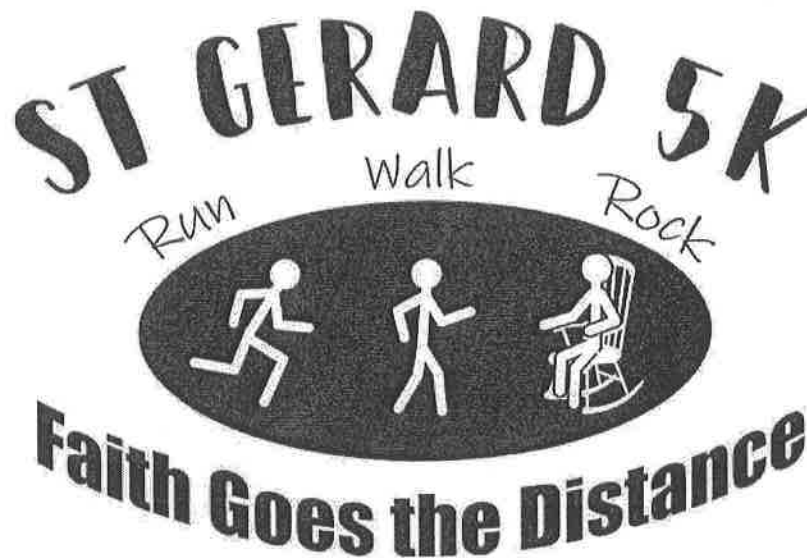

It is not too late to register for summer tee-ball or coach pitch baseball. In fact, we would love to have a few more Coach Pitch Baseball players for this summer so we can add a fourth team! Registration forms can be completed and submitted to the school office, attention Marcus Wasilevich. Your child does not have to be a student at St. Gerard in order to play... all are welcome!

The tee ball and coach pitch teams will meet Tuesday and Thursday nights, beginning June 4<sup>th</sup> and continuing through July 11<sup>th</sup> (Rain-out make-up date July 16). Tee-ball will meet from 6:00-7:00, and Coach Pitch will meet from 7:15-8:15. There will be no games the week of July 4.
