

# 2019/2020 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Washington D.C. Fundraising

There are many fundraising opportunities available to help offset the cost of the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Washington D.C. trip. Below is a list of the current fundraisers. Note that while all fundraisers can be used towards student's trip cost, only select fundraisers can be used towards a parent's trip cost. In order for a student to be eligible to receive funds from the General Account Fundraisers, a parent/student must complete a minimum of 8 hours volunteer time. **To complete the volunteer hours, you must chair a fundraiser or volunteer during a General Account Fundraiser. Chairing a fundraiser will complete your 8 hours of service.**

## Individual Account Fundraisers

*The money earned by your student/family in these fundraisers will be applied directly to your students account.*

**Note that participation in these activities does not count towards your minimum 8 hours of volunteer time for the General Account Fund.**

Book Covering--total money earned divided by number of shifts worked

**\*\*Spartan Football Concessions - Can be used towards parent trip cost**

**\*\*Texas Holdem' Poker Tournaments - Can be used towards parent trip cost**

**\*\*Common Ground**

**\*\*Total money earned from each event will be divided using the total number of shifts worked for the season.**

For example: If \$1000 was raised at all Common Ground with 40 total shifts for the football season and you worked 3 of those shifts: your portion would be \$75.

$\$1000/40 \text{ shifts} = \$25 \text{ per shift}$      $3 \times \$25 = \$75$     (these numbers are not actual, just examples)

**\*\*These 3 fundraisers are the only ones that can be used towards the parent trip.**

## General Account Fundraisers

*The money from these fundraisers will be put into a General Account. Each family that completes a minimum 8 hours of volunteer work will receive an equal percentage of the General Account.*

*For Example: If \$10,000 is raised from all general account fundraisers and 20 families complete their 8 hours of volunteer time, each of the 20 families would receive \$500.*

$\$10,000/20 = \$500$     (these numbers are not actual, just examples)
